Reason for Change

This Change Order adds an item to pay for the installation of barbed wire fence at Olson Meadows Park. This fence replaces an existing fence that was removed to complete the roadway widening. Fern Bluff MUD requested that the fence be replaced to prevent parking on the slope. The new fencing will be located at the right of way line.
