

WCEMS CHP Scope of Work

1. CHP will provide at least 12 educational sessions and trainings to workers in congregate settings, high-risk populations, and other hard-to-reach groups to increase vaccine confidence.
 - a) CHP will identify congregate settings and vulnerable populations to target
 - b) CHP will review all applicable guidance regarding vaccinations and vaccine hesitancy
 - c) CHP will contact all facilities and set up training sessions
 - d) CHP will prepare all digital materials and handouts
 - e) CHP will provide onsite and/or virtual training to identified groups
 - f) CHP will utilize their own devices, technology, and software to implement training and will work in conjunction with WCCHD to print materials
 - g) CHP will attend meetings with team members and participate in additional communications needed to develop and implement project
2. CHP will assist in hosting and coordinating at least 15 vaccination events within HEZs and high SV census tracts
 - a) CHP will in conjunction with WCCHD identify HEZs and SV census tracts using the WCCHD data
 - b) CHP will reach out to community leaders in identified areas and coordinate vaccine events
 - c) CHP will organize events and provide incident command during events as well as ensure that medical oversight is present as directed by WCCHD
 - d) CHP will gather all data during event and coordinate with WCCHD to report data
 - e) CHP will attend meetings with team members and participate in additional communications needed to develop and implement project
