- Route condensate line to sink drain.
- Provide and Install GRDs per plans in rooms 129A and 129B.
- New ductwork to be insulated with R-6 duct wrap.
- Test & Balance new Grilles.

- Provide and Install electric service for CU and AHU.
- Provide and Install disconnects for CU & AHU.
- Provide conduit and box for wired thermostat controller

- Provide and Install Roof Cap for OA duct.

MEETING MINUTES:

- Angel went over alarm that went off in alpha pod. Concern is that part of the work from impact and subs made alarm go off, it appears the alpha pod has nothing to do with RTU units. RTU 1r has supervisory alert on it but that should not have any issue on alarm going off on other side of building. Angel wants josh to check with team. Angel suggest we need to get impact out to do test for NAC card, one is NAC 1 one is NAC 4. Daniel said in last meeting there were numerous supervisory alerts on panels so having one new one should not be a huge issue, until smoke detectors are back in, troubles on panel will not go away. This week power and wires will be connected for all units. Angel is requesting crews take pictures of panels after units are connected to document issues still showing up. Angel requested for Josh to repair landscaping once units are clear from storage area. There will be a Thanksgiving event on the 19th, if work can be mitigated to not interfere as much that would be great. People will be coming to facility all day. Around 400 people will be coming throughout day, Tomorrow (the 17th) and Monday (22nd) crane will be out. Crane lifting again on the 29th.
- status update: josh has submitted change order for records room, but could not get unit that was specified, long lead times, craig said he was fine with a recessed unit that is recessed above ceiling. county is okay with it. Antonio suggesting checking ceiling space to make sure unit can fit in there. We are putting in new ceiling so we can lower it if we need to. No lead time for new unit it is in stock, josh asking how to interface with ceiling work, angel saying josh will do his work first, nobody will be occupying the space.
- josh is connecting gas piping on units, and they should be done this week, automated logic is doing controllers.
