In re: Notice of Contract Termination for Elections Asset Tracking Software (Williamson County, Texas) effective February 25, 2022

To Whom It May Concern:

The Williamson County Elections Department is currently in a contract with your company as referenced above. The Williamson County Commissioners Court has decided and approved changes in this category of services, including the present contract. Pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the contract, paragraph 8.2, which allows for termination, the relevant provision states as follows:

<u>Termination for Convenience</u>: This agreement may be terminated at any time at the option of either party, without future or prospective liability for performance upon giving thirty (30) days written notice thereof. In the event of termination, Customer will only be liable for its pro rata share of services rendered and goods actually received.

Therefore, the purpose of this letter is to give you official notice that Williamson County elects to terminate the agreement between the parties for software and services, and such termination will be effective at the end of business on February 25, 2022.
