The Commissioners Court of Williamson County, Texas will meet in special session in the Commissioners Courtroom, 710 Main Street, in Georgetown, Texas to consider the following items:

1. Discuss, consider and take appropriate action on extending a Declaration of a Local State of Disaster for Williamson County, Texas issued by Williamson County Judge Bill Gravel, Jr. on March 21, 2022 in relation to the severe weather event consisting of multiple tornados, high winds and severe thunderstorms experienced in Williamson County, Texas on said date (Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code).
2. Discuss, consider and take appropriate action on waiving the (1) surcharge fee of 14.5% under Section 3.3(a) of the Landfill Operation Agreement; (2) 2% of the Tip Fee under Section 2.9(c) of the Landfill Operation Agreement; (3) 1% of the Tip Fee under Section 3.5(a) of the Landfill Operation Agreement; (4) 2% of the Tip Fee under Section 3.5(d) of the Landfill Operation Agreement; and (5) 1% of the Tip Fee under Section 2.16(a) of the Landfill Operation Agreement to preserve public health and safety in relation to the collection by the City of Round Rock and its waste collection contractor, Central Texas Refuse, of debris resulting from property damage caused by the severe tornadic weather event in Round Rock on March 21, 2022, with such waivers continuing until April 9, 2022.
3. Discuss, consider and take appropriate action on approving the appropriation of the County's tip fee exclusion for up to 750 tons of Acceptable Waste under Section 3.1(b) of the Landfill Operation Agreement for debris collection resulting from property damage caused by the severe tornadic weather event in the unincorporated areas of Williamson County, with such appropriation continuing until April 9, 2022.
4. Deliberate, discuss, consider, receive information/situational updates and take any appropriate action on public health and safety related matters, issues, business and concerns resulting from and pertaining to the severe weather event consisting of multiple tornados, high winds and severe thunderstorms experienced in Williamson County, Texas on March 21, 2022.
5. Comments from Commissioners.
6. **Public Comment Period.** The Commissioners Court will conduct a Public Comment Period to allow members of the public to address the Court regarding matters pertaining to or affecting Williamson County but that do not appear as an Agenda Item on a meeting's Agenda. During such Public Comment Period, speakers shall be limited to a maximum of two (2) minutes to make his/her remarks and the maximum overall discussion time allowed for the Public Comment Period, regardless of the number of members of the public wishing to address the Court during such period, shall be limited to ten (10) minutes. Speaking time, to the extent possible, will be evenly allocated among speakers should more than five (5) speakers desire to speak during the Public Comment Period. Please note that the members of the Court may not comment at the meeting about matters that are not on the agenda.

## COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER EXTENDING DECLARATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER FOR WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TEXAS

---

**WHEREAS**, on March 21, 2022, the Williamson County Judge issued an Order Declaring a Local State of Disaster for Williamson County, Texas (the “Declaration and Order”) after making a determination based on statements and information provided to him by Williamson County Emergency Management personnel, state and local officials, and other emergency services agencies serving Williamson County, Texas that extraordinary measures must continue to be taken to alleviate and prevent the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property due to severe weather conditions consisting of multiple tornadoes, high winds and severe thunderstorms event experienced in Williamson County, Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the conditions necessitating declaration of a local state of disaster continue to exist in Williamson County, Texas in relation to the aforementioned event experienced in Williamson County, Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, §418.108(b) of the *Texas Government Code* provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY GRANTED IN THE TEXAS DISASTER ACT OF CHAPTER 418 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TEXAS THAT THE DECLARATION AND ORDER IS HEREBY EXTENDED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Pursuant to the authority granted under the laws of the State of Texas, Williamson County may take all legal actions necessary to protect the health of persons in Williamson County, Texas;
2. Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the *Texas Government Code*, the recovery and rehabilitation aspects of the Williamson County Emergency Management Plan and authority to furnish aid and assistance under the Declaration and Order, as well as the preparedness and response aspects of the Williamson County Emergency Management Plan shall continue during the effective period of this extension;

3. Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the *Texas Government Code*, the extension of the Declaration and Order shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Williamsons County Clerk;
4. The Declaration and Order shall be extended and continue until either it is terminated by order of the Williamson County Commissioners Court or April 27, 2022, whichever event occurs first; and
5. This Commissioners Court Order is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to the Williamson County Emergency Management Plan and shall become effective on the date of its adoption.
