- Attach the employee's current job description to the email
- Submitted nominations must include a fully completed nomination form and job description by the deadline (May 13th) to be considered
- Nominees must be in good standing with the County to be considered

Awards for each of the Employee of the Year categories will consist of:

- \$500 Cash*
- Engraved award
- Newspaper ad announcement of the winners
- Public recognition ceremony

Additional Rules:

- Employees cannot nominate family related by blood or marriage
- An employee may be nominated by more than one employee in more than one category, but can only win one category. Receiving multiple nominations does not increase chances of winning
- Nominees may be a County staff member in the nominating County employee's department/office, or in another County department/office
- Employees may not nominate themselves, an elected official or senior department head
- A department/office can have only one individual winner in an employee category. An employee can win as part of a project team, even if they have also won an employee category
- Employees cannot win the same category two years in a row
- To be eligible for the Wilco Way Management category, management is defined as having hiring/firing/evaluation responsibilities for at least one direct report employee
