FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT REGARDING THE CITY/COUNTY PARTICIPATION IN THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION COSTS RELATED TO THE GEORGETOWN SOUTHWEST BYPASS CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

STATE OF TEXAS \$ \$ KNOW ALL BY THESE PRESENTS COUNTY OF WILLIAMSON \$

This First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement ("First Amendment") is entered into between the City of Georgetown, Texas, a municipal corporation (the "City") and Williamson County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas (the "County").

WHEREAS, on or about February 8, 2022, the City and the County entered into an Interlocal Agreement (the "Agreement") regarding the design and construction of an extension of the Southwest Bypass from Wolf Ranch Parkway to SH29 (the "Southwest Bypass Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City and the County desire to amend the Agreement to include the construction of a ten-foot-wide sidewalk within the City's right-of-way for the Southwest Bypass from the north bank of the San Gabriel River to just South of SH 29 (the "Sidewalk Project");

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and agreements contained in this First Amendment, the City and the County agree as follows:

I. Purpose

1.01. <u>General</u>. The purpose of this First Amendment is to allow for the County to design and construct the Sidewalk Project within City right-of-way as part of the Southwest Bypass Project, at the location shown on Exhibit "A", attached hereto.

II
Design and Construction of the Southwest Bypass Project

2.02. <u>Design and Construction Cost is amended to include the cost of the Sidewalk Project</u>: The County shall be responsible for all costs associated with the design and construction of the Sidewalk Project which is estimated to have a construction cost of \$500,000.00.

III. City Obligations

3.02. <u>Permission to Construct</u>: The City agrees to allow the County to construct the Sidewalk Project within the City's ROW boundaries. The City further agrees to accept maintenance of the Sidewalk Project after the City has accepted the Project.

IV. Other Terms of Agreement

4.01. Other Terms: The original Agreement approved by the City and the County on February 8, 2022 shall remain in full force and effect.
