Reduce funding to the Yellow House Foundation (Highlighted Purple)

Amount reduced: \$300,000

Increase funding to Helping Hands of Georgetown/Social Service Food Pantry (Highlighted Green)

Original allocation: \$0

Amount increased: \$30,000

Increase funding to Key2Free/Social Service Medical Services (Highlighted Green)

Original allocation: \$0

Amount increased: \$78,200

Increase funding to Impact Counseling Services/Social Service (Highlighted Green)

Original allocation: \$0

Amount increased: \$50,000

Increase funding to Hutto Resource Center/Social Service Mortgage Assistance (Highlighted Green)

Original allocation: \$0

Amount increased: \$50,000

Increase funding to the Georgetown Housing Authority (Highlighted Green)

Original allocation: \$208,200

Amount increased: \$91,800

Total: \$300,000
