RESOLUTION

A resolution of the Commissioners' Court of the County of Williamson, Texas hereby authorizing the submittal of a grant application to the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP), 2023 Urban Area Security Initiative – Regular Projects (UASI-R) for the Williamson County Hazmat Monitor/Suit/SCBA Maintenance Project. The (HSGP), (UASI-R) grant application number is 4893401.

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners' Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Williamson County, that the Hazmat Monitor/Suit/SCBA Maintenance Project Grant Application be submitted to the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP), 2023 Urban Area Security Initiative – Regular Projects (UASI-R); and

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners' Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP), 2023 Urban Area Security Initiative – Regular Projects (UASI-R) funds, the Williamson County Commissioners' Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP), 2023 Urban Area Security Initiative – Regular Projects (UASI-R) in full; and

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners' Court designates the Honorable Bill Gravell Jr., Williamson County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Williamson County Commissioners' Court approves submission of the grant application to the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP), 2023 Urban Area Security Initiative – Regular Projects (UASI-R) for the Williamson County Hazmat Monitor/Suit/SCBA Maintenance Project.
