

RESOLUTION R23-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TAYLOR, TEXAS EXTENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF ITS FIRE DEPARTMENT SERVICE AREA TO INCLUDE AREAS FORMERLY SERVED BY THE TAYLOR VOLUNTEER (AVERY PICKETT) FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Taylor, Texas intends to extend its fire department service area to include the areas formerly served by the Taylor Volunteer (Avery Pickett) Fire Department.

WHEREAS, the Taylor Volunteer (Avery Pickett) Fire Department has disbanded leaving those areas without fire protection.

WHEREAS, the City will be compensated in accordance with the Williamson County Emergency Service Organizations agreement.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it to be in the best interest of the City to extend fire department services to these areas.

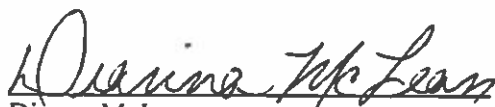
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAYLOR, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City of Taylor will extend its Fire Department service area to areas formerly served by the Taylor Volunteer (Avery Pickett) Fire Department identified in Exhibit "A" as "Uncovered Avery Pickett".

Section 2. The City of Taylor will provide fire suppression, rescue, and EMS first response services to these areas. Fire code enforcement, and fire investigation services will remain under the jurisdiction of the Williamson County Fire Marshal until such time when the areas may be annexed by the City.
