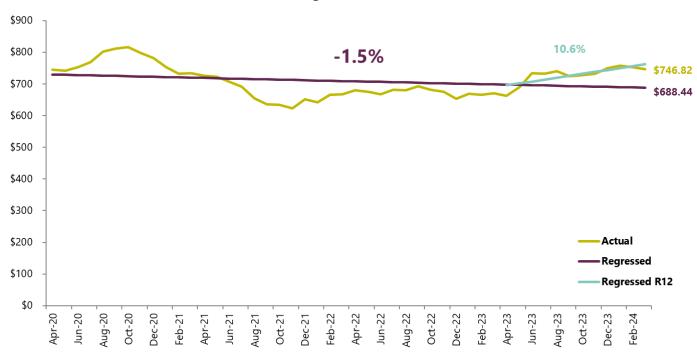

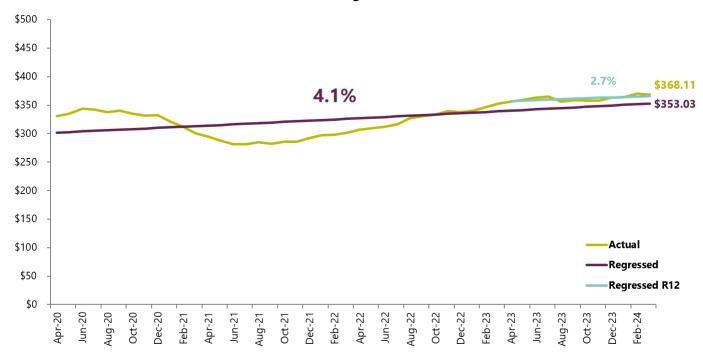
#### **Look- Back Rolling 12 Medical Claims**

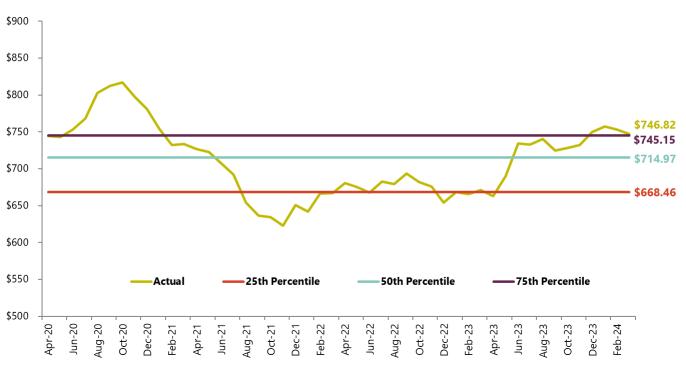
#### **Look-Back Rolling 12 Rx Claims**

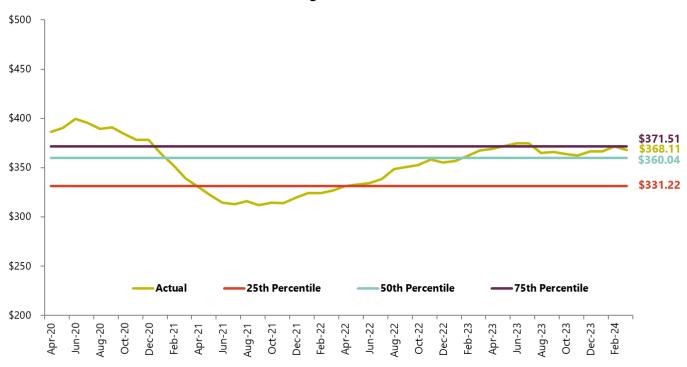
#### Past Coverage Level (PCL) - Medical

Gross pharmacy claims before Rx rebates

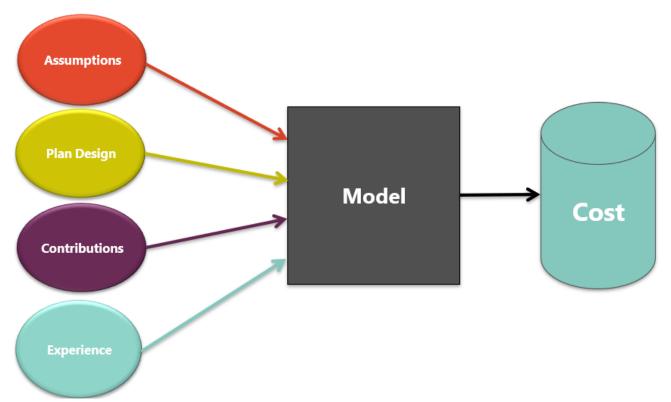
