Reason for Change

This Change Order provides compensation to the Contractor for modifying the encasement length and elevation of the Jonah water line under US 79 and UPRR. These changes were necessary to clear a conflict with an existing gas line and to provide encasement for the water line throughout the UPRR ROW. In addition, this Change Order compensates the Contractor for abandoning the existing 2" Jonah water line located within UPRR ROW on the South side of US 79.
