RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF HARRIS COUNTY CULTURAL EDUCATION FACILITIES FINANCE CORPORATION HOSPITAL REVENUE BONDS (TEXAS CHILDREN’S HOSPITAL) SERIES 2024 TO FINANCE AND REFINANCE THE COSTS OF CERTAIN FACILITIES FOR THE TEXAS CHILDREN’S HOSPITAL AND WITH RESPECT TO A PUBLIC HEARING

was duly introduced for the consideration of said Commissioners Court. It was then duly moved and seconded that said resolution be adopted; and, after due discussion, said motion, carrying with it the adoption of said resolution, prevailed and carried by the following vote: [Ayes: __; Noes: __; Abstentions: __.]

A true, full and correct copy of the aforesaid resolution adopted at the meeting described in the above and foregoing paragraph is attached to and follows this certificate; said resolution has been duly recorded in said Commissioners Court’s minutes of said meeting; the above and foregoing paragraph is a true, full and correct excerpt from said Commissioners Court’s minutes of said meeting pertaining to the adoption of said resolution; the persons named in the above and foregoing paragraph are the duly chosen, qualified and acting officers and members of said Commissioners Court as indicated therein; each of the officers and members of said Commissioners Court was duly and sufficiently notified officially and personally, in advance, of the date, hour, place and purpose of the aforesaid meeting, and that said resolution would be introduced and considered for adoption at said meeting, and each of said officers and members consented, in advance, to the holding of said meeting for such purpose; and said meeting was open to the public as required by law; and public notice of the date, hour, place and subject of said meeting was given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.

WHEREAS, the Harris County Cultural Education Facilities Finance Corporation (the “Issuer”) is authorized, pursuant to the Cultural Education Facilities Finance Corporation Act, Texas Local Government Code Chapter 337 (the “Enabling Act”), to issue revenue bonds to finance and refinance the cost of cultural and/or health facilities, and to make loans to provide for financing or refinancing of the cost of such facilities; and

WHEREAS, Texas Children’s Hospital (“Texas Children’s”) has requested that the Issuer issue, and the Issuer has approved the issuance of, its Hospital Revenue Bonds (Texas Children’s Hospital) Series 2024 in one or more series (collectively, the “Bonds”), pursuant to the Enabling Act, and a loan of the proceeds of the Bonds to Texas Children’s to finance and/or refinance the costs of certain facilities owned and/or operated and/or to be owned and/or operated by Texas Children’s and/or its non-profit affiliates (as described more particularly in **Schedule 1 to Exhibit A** hereto), which are facilities are and will be located throughout the State of Texas (the “Facilities”); and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Facilities consisting of the following sites are and/or will be located in Williamson County, Texas (the “County”): a health facility located at 9835 N Lake Creek Parkway, Austin, TX 78717 (the “Local Portion of the Facilities”);

WHEREAS, the aggregate maximum stated principal amount of the Bonds to be issued on a tax-exempt basis to be used to finance and/or refinance the Facilities is \$270,000,000 (provided that an additional amount of bonds may be issued on a taxable basis) and the aggregate maximum stated principal amount of the Bonds to be used to finance and refinance the Local Portion of the Facilities is \$35,000,000; and

WHEREAS, Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”), requires that the Bonds and the Facilities to be financed with proceeds of the Bonds be approved by the “applicable elected representative” (the “AER”) of the governmental unit having jurisdiction over the area in which the Facilities are or will be located, after a public hearing following reasonable public notice; and

WHEREAS, with respect to the Bonds and the Local Portion of the Facilities, the Commissioners Court (the “Commissioners Court”) of the County is an AER; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing with respect to the Bonds was held on July 18, 2024 (the “Public Hearing”) by the duly appointed hearing officer of the Issuer (the “Hearing Officer”), notice of such Public Hearing having been published not less than seven days before the day of such Public Hearing in a newspaper of general circulation available to residents within the boundaries of the County, all as shown in **Exhibit A** attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the issuance of the Bonds and the action of the Commissioners Court with respect to the matters described herein will create no liability for the County or its residents;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

1. All actions taken by or on behalf of the County or the Issuer with respect to the appointment of the Hearing Officer, the publication of the Notice of the Public Hearing and the conducting of such Public Hearing are hereby authorized, approved and ratified.

2. In order to comply with Section 147(f) of the Code, the Public Hearing has been held by or on behalf of the County, in which hearing members of the public were permitted to express their views with respect to the Facilities and the issuance of the Bonds for such purpose. Notice of such hearing was published no less than seven days prior to such hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the County, and an affidavit of the publication of such notice and a copy of such notice are each attached to **Exhibit A** hereto. Based upon the results of such hearing (as shown in the certificate of public hearing officer attached hereto as **Exhibit A**), and for purposes of complying with Section 147(f) of the Code, the issuance of the Bonds for the Local Portion of the Facilities is hereby approved.

3. THE COUNTY, THE COMMISSIONERS COURT, THE COUNTY JUDGE AND ALL OTHER COUNTY OFFICIALS MAKE NO REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY OF ANY KIND WHATSOEVER WITH RESPECT TO THE FACILITIES OR THE ISSUANCE, CREDITWORTHINESS OR REPAYMENT OF THE BONDS TO BE ISSUED BY THE ISSUER WITH RESPECT TO THE FACILITIES. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL THE COUNTY HAVE ANY LIABILITY, FINANCIAL OBLIGATION OR RESPONSIBILITY OF ANY KIND WITH RESPECT TO THE PAYMENT OF BONDS ISSUED FOR THE FACILITIES OR FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, OPERATION OR ANY OTHER ASPECT OF THE FACILITIES.

4. The County Judge and County Clerk of the County and other officers or representatives of the County are hereby authorized to execute and deliver such instruments, certificates, or documents necessary or advisable to carry out the intent and purpose of this resolution.

5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and shall continue in force and effect from the date hereof.



Hospital Revenue Bonds
(Texas Children's Hospital)
Series 2019B, the proceeds of
