This Change Order provides the balancing for the vegetative watering item used on the project. This Change Order accounts for the final balancing of items on the project.

This Change Order results in a net decrease of \$49,103.60 to the Contract amount, for an adjusted Contract total of \$5,711,847.02. The original Contract amount was \$5,917,275.00. As a result of this and all Change Orders to-date, \$205,427.98 has been deducted from the Contract, resulting in a 3.47% net decrease in the Contract cost.
