ADDENDUM TO THE MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH

Animal Balance

THIS ADDENDUM TO MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT (hereinafter "Addendum") is made and entered into by and between Williamson County, Texas ("County"), a political subdivision of the State of Texas, acting herein by and through its governing body, and Animal Balance a non-profit organization (hereinafter "Service Provider"), both of which are referred to herein as the parties. The County agrees to engage Service Provider as an independent contractor, to provide certain services described herein pursuant to the following terms, conditions, and restrictions:

I.

<u>Incorporated Documents</u>: This Addendum constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and may not be modified or amended other than by a written instrument executed by both parties. Documents expressly incorporated (as if copied in full) into this Addendum include the following:

- A. Original Master Services Agreement approved by Williamson County Commissioners Court on February 25, 2025 and
- B. This Addendum.

II.

Approval of Additional Spay/Neuter Surgeries: The following additional spay/neuter surgeries are deemed to be in the public interest for local residents and

incorporated into this Addendum and with the following additional available funding designated as set forth below:

• 150 additional spay/neuter surgeries at the cost of \$100 for each surgery;

III.

Allowable Expenses: This Amendment will change the allowable expenses to add and cover allowed additional costs with a revised total not-to-exceed amount of <u>Fifty</u> <u>Thousand Dollars</u> (\$50,000.00).

IV.

In all other respects, the Master Services Agreement is reaffirmed.
