

Atmos Energy Corporation Aboveground Facilities Easement Williamson County 179 acre tract William Addison league, A-21 Georgetown, Williamson Co., Texas February 2023 (Revised Nov. 2024)

All that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being situated in the William Addison league, abstract no. 21, in Williamson County, Texas, being a 50 ft. square tract of land within the remainder of that 179.2993 acre tract described in the deed to Williamson County Judge John Doerfler recorded as document no. 199975478 of the Official Public Records of Williamson County, Texas, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron rod with an aluminum cap stamped "COG 4933 ROW" found at a point of curvature in the northwest right-of-way boundary of Southeast Inner Loop (120' width) as described in the deed to the City of Georgetown recorded as document no. 2019065521 of the Official Public Records of Williamson County, Texas, located 531.3 feet southwest of an iron rod with an aluminum cap stamped "COG 4933 ROW" found at its intersection with the southwest right-of-way boundary of Southwestern Boulevard as described in the deed to the City of Georgetown recorded as document no. 2011018248 of the Official Public Records of Williamson County, Texas, and from where another iron rod with an aluminum cap stamped "COG 4933" ROW" found at a point of curvature in the said northwest boundary of Southeast Inner Loop bears N 65° 22' 19" E - 405.7 feet;

Thence N 65° 22' 19" E – 46.25 feet, along a northwest right-of-way line of Southeast Inner Loop to the southwest corner and **Point of Beginning** of this described 50 ft. x 50 ft. square permanent easement tract:

Thence through the said 179.2993 acre tract, in a clockwise direction around this described permanent easement tract as follows:

N 24° 37' 41" W - 50.00 feet to its northwest corner:

N 65° 22' 19" E - 50.00 feet to its northeast corner;

S 24° 37' 41" E - 50.00 feet to its southeast corner;

and S 65° 22' 19" W – 50.00 feet, along the said northwest right-of-way line of Southeast Inner Loop, to the Point of Beginning and containing 2,500 square feet (0.0574 acre) of land more or less.

Bearings are Texas State Plane, Central Zone, NAD-83 datum, based on GPS observations recorded in February 2023. referenced to the Leica SmartNet RTK network.

All that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being situated in the William Addison league, abstract no. 21, in Williamson County, Texas, being a horseshoe-shaped 25 ft. wide strip of land contiguous with the boundary of a 50 ft. square permanent easement tract also surveyed on this date within the remainder of that 179.2993 acre tract described in the deed to Williamson County Judge John Doerfler recorded as document no. 199975478 of the Official Public Records of Williamson County, Texas, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron rod with an aluminum cap stamped "COG 4933 ROW" found at a point of curvature in the northwest right-of-way boundary of Southeast Inner Loop (120' width) as described in the deed to the City of Georgetown recorded as document no. 2019065521 of the Official Public Records of Williamson County, Texas, located 531.3 feet southwest of an iron rod with an aluminum cap stamped "COG 4933 ROW" found at its intersection with the southwest right-of-way boundary of Southwestern Boulevard as described in the deed to the City of Georgetown recorded as document no. 2011018248 of the Official Public Records of Williamson County, Texas, and from where another iron rod with an aluminum cap stamped "COG 4933" ROW" found at a point of curvature in the said northwest boundary of Southeast Inner Loop bears N 65° 22' 19" E – 405.7 feet;

Thence N 65° 22' 19" E – 21.25 feet, along a northwest right-of-way line of Southeast Inner Loop to the southwest corner and Point of Beginning of this described temporary workspace tract;

Thence N 65° 22' 19" E –25.00 feet, along the said northwest right-of-way line of Southeast Inner Loop, to the southwest corner of the said 50 ft. square easement tract also surveyed on this date;

Thence through the said 179.2993 acre tract, in a clockwise direction contiguous with the boundary of the said 50 ft. square easement tract as follows:

N 24° 37' 41" W - 50.00 feet to its northwest corner:

N 65° 22' 19" E - 50.00 feet to its northeast corner:

S 24° 37' 41" E - 50.00 feet to its southeast corner;

Thence N 65° 22' 19" E –25.00 feet, along the said northwest right-of-way line of Southeast Inner Loop, to the southeast corner of this described temporary workspace;

Thence through the said 179.2993 acre tract, in a counterclockwise direction, 25.00 feet away from and parallel to the boundary lines of the said 50 ft. square easement tract, as follows:

N 24° 37' 41" W – 75.00 feet to the northeast corner of this described workspace tract:

S 65° 22' 19" W – 100.00 feet to the northwest corner of this described workspace tract;

and S 24° 37' 41" E - 75.00 feet to the Point of Beginning and containing 5,000 square feet

(0.1148 acre) of land more or less.

Bearings are Texas State Plane, Central Zone, NAD-83 datum, based on GPS observations recorded in February 2023, referenced to the Leica SmartNet RTK network.
