## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY, GEORGETOWN TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM (HMGP) APPLICATION TO THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ADMINISTRATION (FEMA) THROUGH THE TEXAS DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (TDEM) FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PROJECT IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF WEIR; AND TO ACT AS THE APPLICANT TO FEMA AND TDEM ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WEIR FOR AN EMERGENCY WARNING SYSTEM; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE OR PRESIDING OFFICER TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE FEMA HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of Williamson County to apply for funding under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program; and

WHEREAS; a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Williamson County and the City of Weir acknowledges that the City of Weir accepts responsibility for all matching funds and related expenses associated with the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY, GEORGETOWN, TEXAS:

- 1. That Williamson County is authorized to submit an application on behalf of the City of Weir for FEMA Mitigation Funds for an emergency warning system.
- That Commissioners Court directs and designates the Judge or Presiding Officer as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application.
- 3. That the City of Weir through a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Williamson County is committing to provide 25% or more matching funds in contribution to the FEMA Mitigation Project.
