A RESOLUTION COMMITTING TO ZERO ROADWAY FATALITIES AND AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR THE SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) GRANT

WHEREAS, Williamson County, Texas recognizes that traffic fatalities and serious injuries are preventable and that no loss of life on our roadways is acceptable; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation's Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program supports local initiatives aimed at eliminating roadway fatalities and serious injuries through a Safe System Approach;

WHEREAS, Williamson County, Texas and regional partners participated in development of the Williamson County Safety Action Plan that identified high-risk areas, analyzed crash data, engaged stakeholders, and outlined strategies to enhance transportation safety;

WHEREAS, the SS4A Implementation Grant provides an opportunity to obtain federal funding to support the design and construction of safety projects; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY, TEXAS, that Williamson County, Texas commits to the vision of zero roadway fatalities and serious injuries by the year 2050, aligning with the objectives of the SS4A program and Texas Road to Zero;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Williamson County will monitor and periodically report on progress toward the road to zero goal; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Williamson County adopts the Williamson County Safety Action Plan and intends to implement projects, strategies, and policies from the plan.
