


Lisa, hi

Attached is the electrical relocation estimate that I received from Edgar Castro, parcel 15 on Bagdad Road. This estimate is to move the electrical from the existing house to allow for the demolition of the house and to reconnect the electrical to his business and also to connect to the RV's that are on the remainder and are being occupied by the displacee's of the house. I've also attached pictures for your reference.

The reinstallation of the electrical was not included as part of the cost to cure for the business. The electric to the business goes through this meter on the house. The RVs were moved on the remainder when the displacee's moved from the house, there was no previous service to the RV's this estimate adds this service.

This is not really an eligible relocation expense, but if approved I will submit it as a direct reimbursement to the parcel owner Edgar Castro.

Please review and let me know if this expense can be reimbursed by Williamson County. If so I will contact Mr. Castro and have him complete the electrical disconnect.

PROJECT PROPOSAL

June 11, 2025

SCOPE OF WORK

- Removal of the existing service conduit and wiring.
- Removal of meter box and main service panel.
- Disconnection of wiring within existing main panel.
- Exposure of underground Schedule 40 PVC conduits.
- Excavation as needing to reroute underground conduits to new service pole.
- Installation of an in-ground pull box to reconnect office wiring to new service.
- Installation of new wiring for RVs, water well and office building.
- Reinstallation of service conduit, new meter box and main disconnect panel.
- Termination of both service and load-side wiring.

COST ESTIMATE

The proposed total cost for the work listed is \$13,380. This amount includes all necessary equipment rentals, materials and labor provided by a licensed Journeyman Electrician and apprentice.

The proposed work will include Pedernales Electric disconnecting the service power.

Removal of service wires from service meter and main panel board.

Removal of service riser conduit and weather head.

Removal of meter box.

Disconnect and removal of wiring from main panel and breaker.

Removal of main panel and sub panel.

Underground schedule 40 PVC conduit will be exposed to a necessary point to redirect conduits to new service pole.

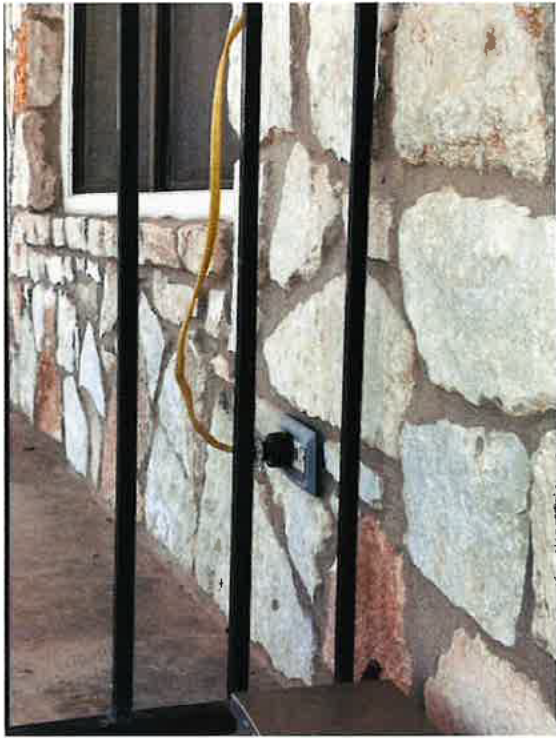
