To the Honorable Members of the Williamson County Commissioners Court,

The Williamson County Salary Grievance Committee (Committee) held a hearing on August 15, 2025 at 8:00 a.m. to consider Williamson County District Attorney, Shawn Dick's request that the Commissioners Court's approved FY 2026 county supplement of \$25,000.00 for the Williamson County District Attorney be increased to \$79,346.82.

Mr. Dick addressed the Committee and provided information relating to his request. The Williamson County Manager, Rebecca Clemons, provided information as to the Commissioners Court's process of setting the county supplement for the Williamson County District Attorney, as well as differences between salary matters relating to county officials and employees and salary matters relating to the Williamson County District Attorney and Williamson County District Judges.

The Committee considered all comments and documentation provided to it and, thereafter, voted 8 in favor of and 1 opposed to an increase to the county supplement for the Williamson County District Attorney in the amount of \$79,346.82 for FY2026.

Since at least 6 members of the Committee voted to recommend the increase, the Williamson County Commissioners Court shall consider the recommendation at its next meeting.
