

ORDER DISSOLVING THE AVERY RANCH ROAD DISTRICT NO. 1

Whereas, on the 27th day of February, 2001, the Williamson County Commissioners Court (the "Commissioners Court") established the Avery Ranch Road District #1 (the "District"); and

Whereas, thereafter the District issued \$17,000,000 aggregate principal amount in voter-approved bonds for purposes of constructing or acquiring the Avery Ranch Boulevard and related improvements (the "Road Bonds") and \$17,455,000 aggregate principal amount in voter-approved bonds for purposes of refunding the Road Bonds (the "Road Refunding Bonds" and collectively with the Road Bonds, the "Bonds"); and

Whereas, all of the Bonds have been paid in full; and

Whereas, the District has no outstanding public securities, as such term is defined in Section 1201.002, Texas Government Code, as amended; and

Whereas, the Commissioners Court now desires to abolish the District pursuant to Section 257.022 of the Texas Transportation Code, as amended; and

Whereas, on _____, 2025, the Commissioners Court held a public hearing in the manner required by law on the abolition of the District.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered by the Williamson County Commissioners Court that the Avery Ranch Road District #1 is abolished and otherwise dissolved.
