
**AMENDMENT TO
WILLIAMSON COUNTY
AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES AND GOODS
Mission Critical Partners LLC
(Body-Worn and In-Car Camera System for Sheriff's Office)**

Important Notice: County Purchase Orders and Contracts constitute expenditures of public funds, and all vendors are hereby placed on notice that any quotes, invoices or any other forms that seek to unilaterally impose contractual or quasicontractual terms are subject to the extent authorized by Texas law, including but not limited to the Texas Constitution, the Texas Government Code, the Texas Local Government Code, the Texas Transportation Code, the Texas Health & Safety Code, and Opinions of the Texas Attorney General relevant to local governmental entities.

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES AND GOODS ("Amendment") is entered into as of the last party's execution hereof, by and between **Williamson County, Texas** ("County"), a political subdivision of the State of Texas, acting herein by and through its governing body, and **Mission Critical Partners LLC** ("MCP"), both of which are referred to herein as the parties.

WHEREAS, the County and MCP entered into an Agreement for Services and Goods, dated effective July 01, 2025 (the "Agreement"), setting forth the terms and conditions pursuant to which MCP agreed to provide certain services;

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement to update the cooperative agreement needed for funding reference to complete the project. The Parties also desire to amend the Agreement to extend the Effective Date and Term due to additional time needed to complete the project.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree that the Agreement is amended as follows:

AMENDMENT

ARTICLE 4 CONTRACT TIME:

4.1 MCP shall commence the Work upon instruction to do so from the County and shall achieve Final Completion on or before September 30, 2026. County shall determine when the Project has been fully and finally completed to its satisfaction. The time set forth for Final Completion of the work is an essential element of the Agreement.

ARTICLE 2 FEE: MCP will be compensated based on the pricing and rates set forth in the attached MCP Proposal dated June 6, 2025 marked as Exhibit "A," which is incorporated herein to the extent it meets or exceeds the requirements of County's solicitation, if applicable and in accordance with Houston Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) Purchase Contract #HP08-25, incorporated by reference. The not-to-exceed amount under this Agreement shall be One Hundred Forty Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Six Dollars and Ninety-One Cents (\$140,546.91).

Entire Agreement & Incorporated Documents Conflicting Terms of the Agreement:

- I. **Entire Agreement & Incorporated Documents:** This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and may not be modified or amended other than by a written instrument executed by both parties. Documents expressly incorporated into this Agreement include the following:
- A. The Original Services Contract, and its Exhibits effective July 01, 2025, incorporated by reference;
 - B. The cooperative purchasing contract HP08-25, incorporated by reference;
 - C. Insurance certificates evidencing coverages required herein above incorporated by reference.

The County reserves the right and sole discretion to determine the controlling provisions where there is any conflict between the terms of this Agreement and the terms of any other purchase order(s), contract(s) or any document attached hereto as exhibits relating to the services and goods subject of this Agreement.


- II. Each party represents and warrants that it has due power and lawful authority to execute and deliver this Amendment and to fulfil its obligations under the Agreement; and, furthermore, the Agreement and this Amendment are the valid, binding, and enforceable obligations of such party.
- III. All other terms of the Agreement which have not been specifically amended herein shall remain the same and shall continue in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have caused this Amendment to be signed by their duly authorized representatives on behalf of such party, to be effective as of the date of the last party's execution hereof.
