**THAT ON THIS**, the 16th day of December 2025, the Commissioners Court of Williamson County, Texas, met in duly called session at the Courthouse in Georgetown, with the following members present;

And at said meeting, among other business, the Court considered the following

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, in 1890, the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) was founded to promote historic preservation, education, and patriotism across the United States; and since the founding, more than one million women have found purpose and passion in DAR membership; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 14, 1925, the Daniel Coleman Chapter, Texas Society Daughters of the American Revolution, was founded as the first DAR chapter in Williamson County; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States of America is celebrating its semiquincentennial in 2026, 250 years since the adoption of the Declaration of Independence, to engage, educate, and unite Americans through programs and special events; and

**WHEREAS**, thanks to a partnership between the Daughters of the American Revolution and the American Battlefield Trust, the American Revolution Experience Traveling Exhibit was created to bring to life the diverse viewpoints and experiences of those who witnessed the dawn of a new nation using touch-screen kiosks, stories, drawings, technology and artifacts; and

**WHEREAS**, the exhibit was purchased by the Texas Society Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR), who created two additional panels that share the contributions of what is now Texas to the Revolutionary War. In addition, Williamson County purchased panels to share the contributions of the forefathers of Williamson County's early settlers. The American Revolution Experience Traveling Exhibit will be sponsored by the Daniel Coleman Chapter and hosted by the Williamson Museum, 716 S. Austin Avenue in Georgetown, from Dec. 10 to Dec. 20, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the American Revolution Experience Traveling Exhibit will be divided and shared from Dec. 21 to Jan. 2 at the Georgetown Public Library, 402 W. 8<sup>th</sup> Street, and the Round Rock Public Library, 200 E. Liberty Ave.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Williamson County Commissioners Court does hereby recognize the Daniel Coleman Chapter, Texas Society Daughters of the American Revolution, on its 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary and encourages all county officials, employees, schools and residents to view the American Revolution Experience Traveling Exhibit to commemorate the start of the year-long celebration of America's 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary.
