

**A Resolution of the Williamson County Commissioners' Court
Approving the Williamson County Project Applications to
Be Submitted to the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning
Organization for the Fiscal Year 2028-2031 Call for Projects**

WHEREAS, the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) has announced a project call for Fiscal Year 2028-2031 for project funding from a variety of funding sources; and

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Commissioner's Court approved and adopted the Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) in October 2009 and subsequent amendments and approved specific funding for the development of projects identified in the LRTP in the FY 2023 budget; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 Road Bond package was approved by the Williamson County voters on November 7, 2023 and the Road and Bridge FY 25 Budget was approved on August 27, 2024.

WHEREAS, the following elements of the Williamson County LRTP, Road and Bridge and 2023 bond program have been identified as being competitive for the CAMPO Fiscal Year 2028-2031 Call for Projects: Precinct 1: Parmer Lane (FM 734) at Texas State Highway 45 Interchange, Robinson Ranch Road, Schultz Lane, Red Bud Lane Widening; Precinct 2: CR 214, Freedom River Parkway East, Freedom River Parkway West, Seward Junction Loop West, Bagdad Road, CR 175; Precinct 3: Ronald Reagan Boulevard Widening, Segment C1, Ronald Reagan Boulevard Widening, Segment C2, Ronald Reagan Boulevard Widening, Segment D1, Ronald Reagan Boulevard Widening, Segment D2, SH 195 at Ronald Reagan Boulevard (3 remaining ramps), Wyoming Springs Drive, CR 239, CR 241, Brushy Creek Trail Gap; Precinct 4: East Wilco Highway, Segment 6, East Wilco Highway, Segment 5, Chandler Road (FM 1660 Overpass), Corridor A2, Segment 1 (FM 973 to CR 406), Corridor A2, Segment 2 (CR 406 to SH 95), CR 138/East Wilco Highway, CR 100, CR 458, CR 305, and SH 95 (North, Central and South).

WHEREAS, if a project listed above is selected, Williamson County is committed to contributing the local funding match;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Williamson County Commissioners' Court:

That the Commissioners' Court of Williamson County does hereby approve submitting project applications to the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Fiscal Year 2028-2031 Call for Projects.

That the Commissioners' Court of Williamson County does hereby authorize the County into entering into an Advanced Funding Agreement with TxDOT on those projects awarded by the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Fiscal Year 2028-2031 Call for Projects.
