Where, among other matters, came up for consideration and adoption the following Resolution:

Whereas, the Williamson County Commissioners Court finds it is in the best interest of the citizens of Williamson County, that Williamson County Juvenile Services accept funding for the Criminal Justice Grants Program, The Transformative Justice Program, Grant Number 5745101, for fiscal year 2027; and

Whereas, the Williamson County Commissioners Court has considered the proposed application for State and Federal Assistance for said project, in the amount of \$164,000.00, and agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Criminal Justice Grants Program grant application; and

Whereas, the Williamson County Commissioners Court agrees in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor, the Williamson County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

Whereas, the Williamson County Commissioners Court has agreed that a designation of the title of an authorized official who is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant is hereby identified as the Williamson County Judge.

Whereas, the Williamson County Commissioners Court designates Julie Kiley, County Auditor, as the grantee’s financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Williamson County Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the Criminal Justice Grants Program, The Transformative Justice Program, Grant Number 5745101, to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
