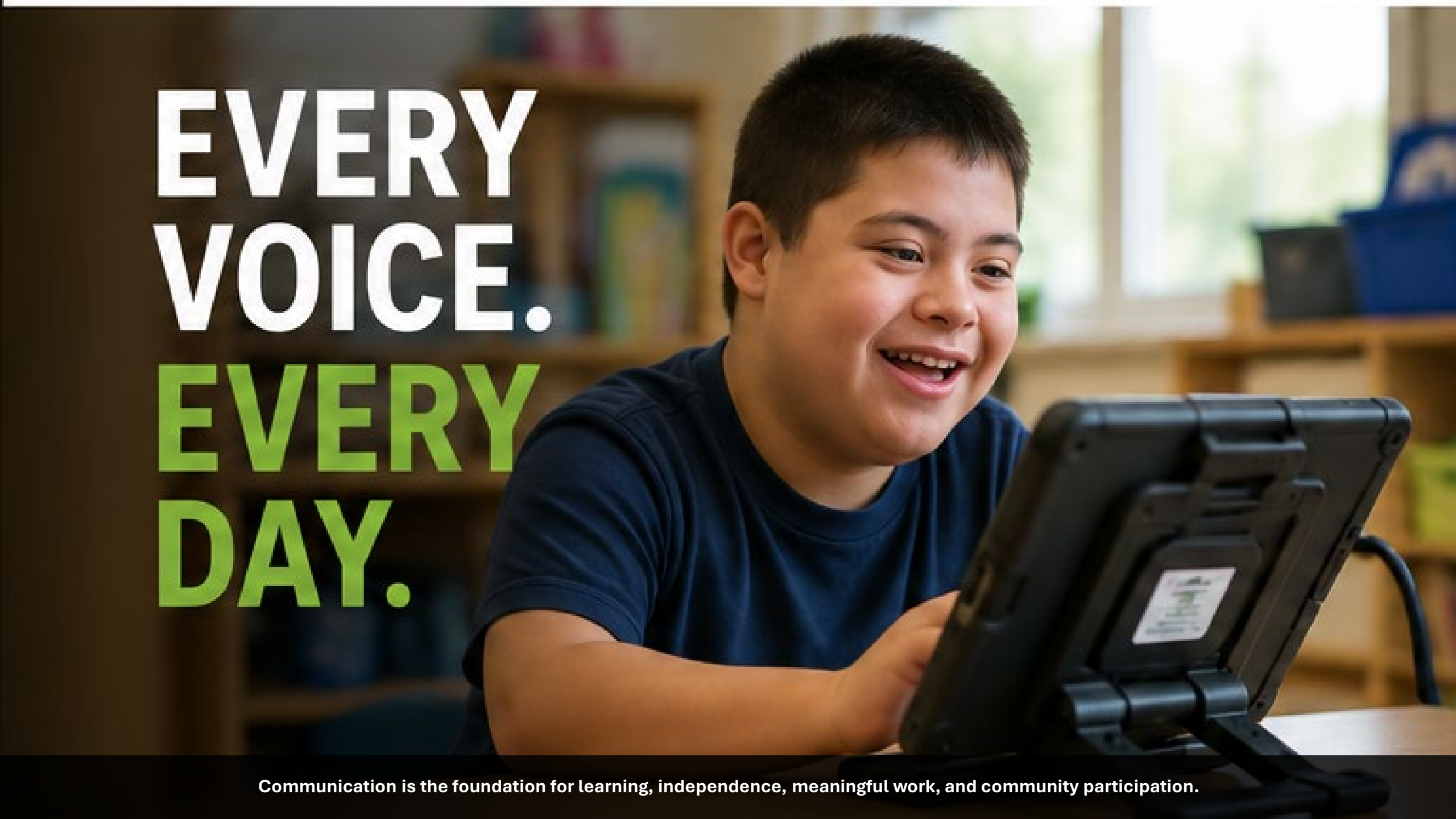

# FACILITY OVERVIEW

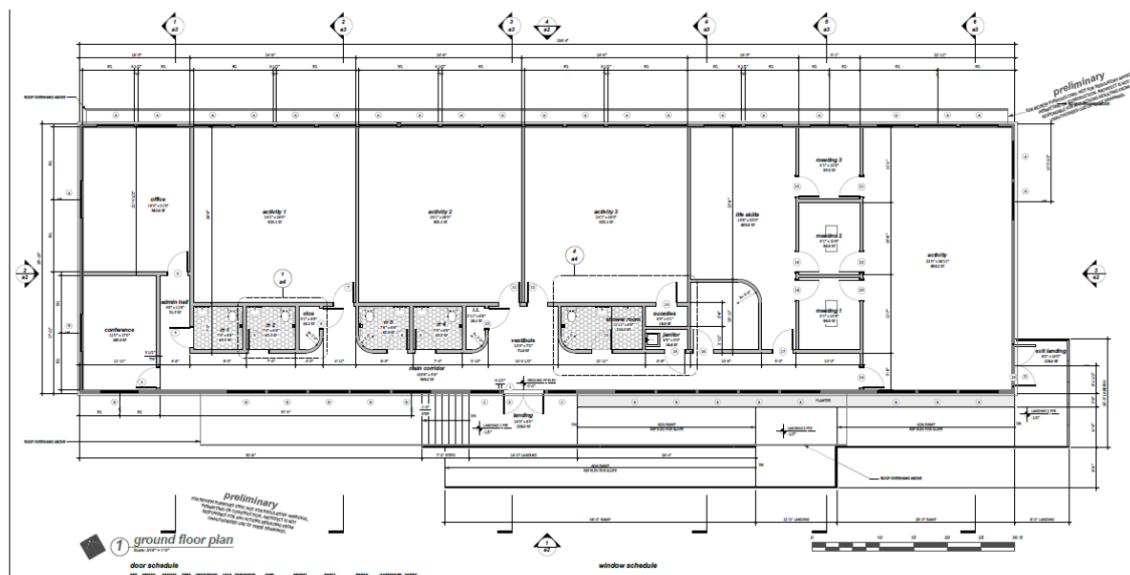


The Academy is designed specifically for citizens with profound intellectual and developmental disabilities and will include:
