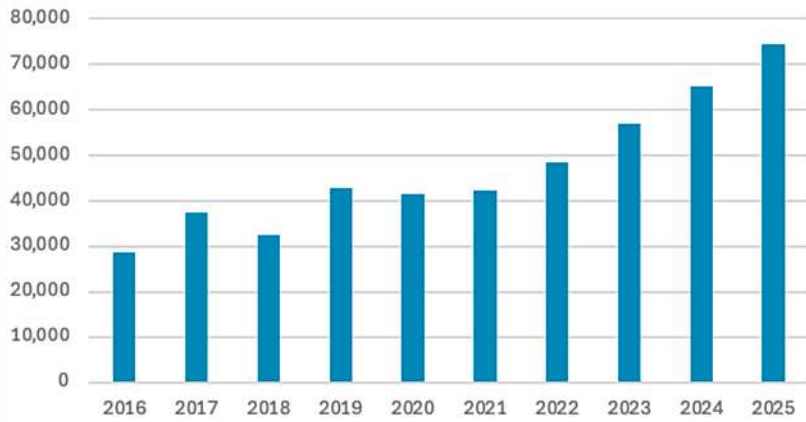
Immediate Needs

- Raise capital funds for new facility - a top priority!
- Blessing Bags: Year-round program that provides students (who qualify for free/reduced lunch) with 2-3 meals and 8-10 snacks each week. We need food donations for the bags. Scan the QR code for a complete list of items.
- Operation Back to School: provides students who qualify with a new pair of athletic shoes, a backpack, and school supplies so students start the new school year prepared and confident.

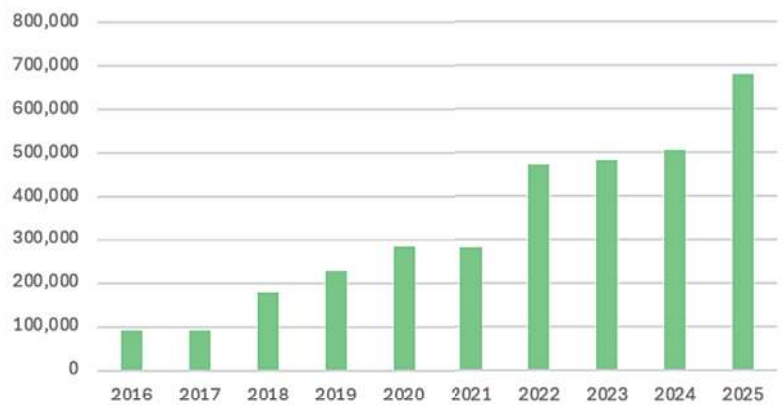
Clothing and Shoes Distributed

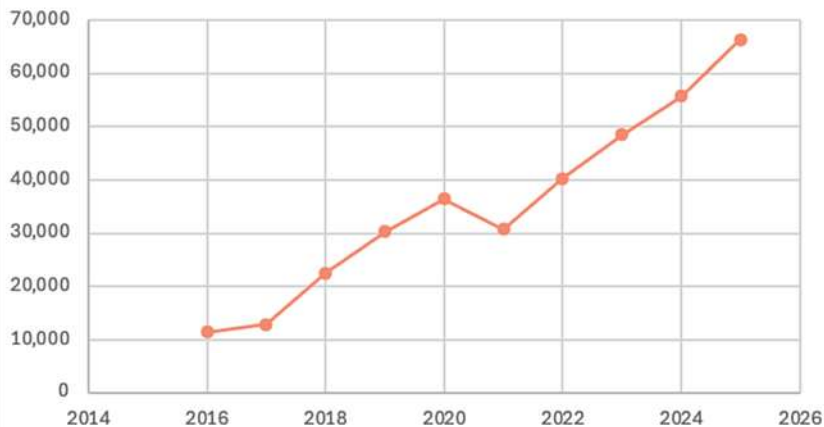
Number of Meals Distributed
