Dear Ms. Rister

This letter is to inform the council that we are strongly opposed to the jail and courthouse expansion being located in our neighborhood for the following reasons:

- growth of a jail population and increased traffic in the area would endanger the lives of the residents;
- increased commercialization in the area would increase the tax rate higher than what most modest incomes in the neighborhood could pay;
- increased taxes would cause people not to be able to pay for their homes and force relocation;
- families living in urban renewal homes should not be subjected to dislocation or disruption of lifestyle.

We strongly urge you to find another alternative for the jail expansion in a less dense, non-residential area.



We, the pastors of the Fellowship of Churches, represent the undersigned who have banded together to share our disappointment in the proposed Zoning Ordinance for the Williamson County Criminal Justice Facility, Block 1, Lot 1 and Block 2, Lot 1 and City of Georgetown, Block 22 parts of Lots 1, 2 and 3 and Block 43, Lots 5-8, located at 6th and Rock streets and Martin Luther King Street.

The quality of life would be greatly strained should this edifice find its home here. We are concerned that in a neighborhood where children play and go to and from school, that this building would loom larger than life in a less than positive way. This neighborhood is already peppered with constant reminders of the penal and correctional systems. The courthouse extension and the bail bondsmen offices are already in abundance in this neighborhood. A jail is quite frankly overkill.

Please note that the undersigned are ardently opposed to any attempt to locate a county jail or any other building of this sort at this site or any place within this neighborhood.


Please expect additional names to be added to the undersigned. We look forward to hearings and will explain in further detail our opposition to locating the Williamson County Justice Facility in this location.




