
The purpose of this no cost modification is to implement some of the terms and conditions of the Hutto Settlement Agreement (HSA) dated 26 August 2007. Accordingly, the following is incorporated into Inter-Governmental Service Agreement (IGSA) DROIGSA-06-0001 as follows:

1. For resident movement, revise the agreement to add the following:

a. Upon execution of this modification, hall passes shall be eliminated and residents shall have, at a minimum, open movement throughout the T. Don Hutto Facility (TDHF) between 0800 and 2000 hours daily. Open movement includes only those areas where residents have authorized access within facility perimeters.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the document referenced in Item 9A or 10A, as heretofore changed, remains unchanged and in full force and effect.

The Provider shall consolidate all Libraries for families into one location containing both general and legal related materials and shall be of multi-purpose usage. At a minimum, the library shall be open and available for use during free movement hours (0800-2000hours).</p> <p>4. Revise Visitation requirements as follows:</p> <p>a. Visitation schedules shall provide equal access in the amount of hours that attorneys and others may visit relatives daily.</p> <p>b. The Provider shall establish visitation policy and procedures and publish via a memorandum to be posted within the facility and updated in the resident handbook.</p> <p>5.
