The purpose of this no cost modification is to implement some of the terms and conditions of the Hutto Settlement Agreement (HSA) dated 26 August 2007. Accordingly, the following is incorporated into Inter-Governmental Service Agreement (IGSA) DROIGSA-06-0001 as follows:

1. For weekend food service, incorporate the following:

a. Brunch style food service provisions will be served from 1100 to 1300 hours on Saturdays and Sundays. Menu will consist of the existing lunch menu, with the addition of one egg entree and one offering of tortilla/bread/pastry item. Alternate entrée during the brunch may be also provided based on acceptability and cost provisions.
