WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Williamson County, Texas, has found and determined that in order to promote the public safety, to facilitate the safety and movement of traffic, and to preserve the financial investment of the public in its roadways, public necessity requires acquisition of fee simple title to 0.447 acres owned by Steven and Janis Gangl (parcel 11), described by metes and bounds in Exhibit "A", for the construction, reconstruction, maintaining, widening, straightening, lengthening, and operating of Highway 79 ("Project"), excluding all the oil, gas, and sulphur which can be removed from beneath said real property, without any right whatever remaining to the owner of such oil, gas, and sulphur of ingress to or egress from the surface of said real property for the purpose of exploring, developing, or mining of the same, as a part of the improvements to the Project, at such locations as are necessary and that such constructing, reconstructing, maintaining, widening, straightening, lengthening, and operating shall extend across and upon, and will cross, run through, and be upon the hereinafter described real properties; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Williamson County, Texas, has, through agents employed by the said office, entered into good faith negotiations with the owners of the hereinafter described properties and has failed to agree with the owners on the compensation and damages, if any, due to said owners. Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF THE COUNTY

OF WILLIAMSON, that the County Attorney or her designated agent be and she is

hereby authorized and directed to file or cause to be filed against the owners of any interest in, and the holders of any lien secured by, the following described tracts of land, described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, a suit in eminent domain to acquire the property interests for the aforesaid purposes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Attorney or her designated agent be and he is hereby authorized and directed to incur such expenses and to employ such experts as she shall deem necessary to assist her in the prosecution of such suit in eminent domain, including, but not limited to, appraisers, engineers, and land use planners.

1) THENCE with said common line, S 21°24'03" E, a distance of 40.35 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod found for the south common corner of said 5.447 acre tract and said 5.00 acre tract, same being in the existing north right-of-way line of said U.S. 79 and in the north line of a called 2.998 acre tract of land conveyed to the State of Texas, as recorded in Volume 448, Page 184, Deed Records of Williamson County, Texas, also being the southeast comer of the tract described herein;

THENCE leaving said common line, with said existing right-of-way line, the following two (2) courses and distances:

- S 76°07'59" W, passing at a distance of 160.18 feet a TxDOT Type I concrete monument found, continuing in all a total distance of 425.05 feet to a calculated point of curvature, and
- 3) with the arc of a curve to the left a distance of 95.96 feet, through a central angle of 01°43'38", having a radius of 3183.10 feet, and whose chord bears \$ 75°16'10" W, a distance of 95.95 feet to the calculated south common corner of said 5.447 acre tract and a called 0.51 acre tract of land described in a deed to Lenz Acres Partnership, as recorded in Document No. 2004058570, Official Public Records of Williamson County, Texas, same being the southwest corner of the tract described herein;

4) THENCE leaving said existing right-of-way line, with the common line of said 5.447 acre tract and said 0.51 acre tract, N 18°01'26" W, a distance of 30.27 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod with a TxDOT aluminum cap set, 107.92 feet left of U.S. 79 Engineer's Centerline Station 1103+76.08, being in said proposed right-of-way line, same being the northwest corner of the tract described herein, from which a 1/2-inch iron rod found for the north common comer of said 5.447 acre tract and said 0.51 acre tract bears, N 18°01'26" W, a distance of 405.73 feet;

THENCE with said proposed right-of-way line, crossing through the interior of said 5.447 acre tract the following two (2) courses and distances:

- 5) with the arc of a curve to the right a distance of 363.24 feet, through a central angle of 03°33'11", having a radius of 5857.55 feet, and whose chord bears N 74°21'23" E, a distance of 363.19 feet to a TxDOT Type II concrete monument set, 106.88 feet left of U.S. 79 Engineer's Centerline Station 1107+32.88, and
- 6) N 76°07'59" E, a distance 154.88 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 0.447 acre (19,478 sq. ft.) of land, more or less.
