Dear Mr. Oldham:

Per our discussions and agreement the City of Cedar Park, Texas through a Federal COPS grant is receiving from Motorola, Inc. a new Archiving Interface Server (AIS) at a quoted value of \$108,473.70, together with a new one (1) year warranty which is a piece of equipment Williamson County, Texas wants and which the City of Cedar Park does hereby give to Williamson County, Texas, to be delivered to and installed by Motorola, Inc. at Williamson County, Texas, at no charge.

Actual delivery date and delivery location will be arranged directly by Williamson County, Texas, with any necessary assistance from the City of Cedar Park, Texas.

In consideration for the above, Williamson County, Texas, agrees to pay for the following equipment already ordered by the City of Cedar Park, one (1) new digital radio upgrade backup RF Equipment Dispatch for a quoted value of \$92,596.95 and eight (8) XTL 1500 Dispatch at a quoted value of \$1,899.00 each, totaling \$15,192.00, for a combined total purchase price of \$107,788.95. The combined total purchase price to be paid for by Williamson County upon the delivery of the equipment.

Williamson County, Texas, and the City of Cedar Park, Texas agree that this is a fair and equal exchange of property with neither Party being subject to any other or future costs or expenses in connection with this transaction and that this letter agreement contains all of their understanding, promises and commitments.
