

COURT ORDER
VOTING EQUIPMENT LEASE FEES

Pursuant to Section 123.032 of the Texas Election Code, a political subdivision may lease voting equipment from a county in which the political subdivision is wholly or partly situated. The maximum amount that a county in which a political subdivision is wholly or partly situated may charge the political subdivision for leasing county-owned equipment is ten percent (10%) of the purchase price of the equipment for each day the equipment is leased.

On this 19th day of August, 2008, the Commissioners Court of Williamson County, Texas, does hereby ORDER that the amounts charged to a political subdivision for leasing voting equipment for early voting and Election Day per piece of equipment shall be, as follows:

DRE voting equipment (iVotronic, ADA)	\$309.50
DRE voting equipment (iVotronic)	\$250.00
Printers for DRE equipment	\$ 85.00
Precinct ballot counter (M-100s)	\$475.00
Electronic Pollbooks	\$274.43

It is further ORDERED that the per piece fee shall be charged once for use during the Early Voting period and once for Election Day.
