WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Williamson County, that the In-Home Family Preservation Program, Application Number 17999-04, be operated for the 4th year; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County Commissioners Court has considered the proposed application for State and Federal Assistance for said project, in the amount of \$26,591.00 to be submitted to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, Fund JJDP Program; and

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners Court has agreed to provide applicable matching funds for the said project, as required by the Governor's Criminal Justice Division grant application; and

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners Court has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, Williamson County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Governor's Criminal Justice Division in full.

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners Court has agreed that a designation of the title of an authorized official who is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant is hereby identified as the Williamson County Judge.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Williamson County Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application to the Governor's Criminal Justice Division for the In-Home Family Preservation Program, Application Number 17999-04, in the amount of \$26,591.00.
