Section 1 – Service Specifications

FDDI, Inc. meets or exceeds all of the listed service specifications. FDDI has provided Williamson County with wireless and networking consulting, support, and maintenance over the past 5 years. FDDI is authorized by Motorola on all of their wireless products as well as the majority of existing radio manufacturers. FDDI proposes a continuation of the service for the County as needed and specified by the County. This service includes but is not limited to:

- Wireless system troubleshooting and support
 - 2 – 4 hour response time or better for emailed or voice requests
 - VPN connectivity for immediate systems review and possible configuration changes as well as firmware upgrades
 - 24 hour response time for on-site support or maintenance at the request of the county
- Wireless system maintenance
 - Periodic firmware upgrades with version recommendations
 - RF characteristics review to determine Bit Error Rates due to interference and other data throughput reducing anomalies
- Wireless and Network Engineering
 - Path analysis and link budget calculations for existing link upgrades and new links that may be added to the system
 - Frequency analysis and recommendations (utilizing high grade spectrum analyzers)
 - Licensed and Unlicensed radio equipment recommendation
 - FCC licenses application and acquisition for the county
 - Wireless data integration within the existing and evolving Cisco switch and router configuration of the county
- Wireless Equipment
 - Equipment will be priced to the county at FDDI's cost. Actual equipment invoices will accompany any invoice to the county for any equipment
 - FDDI will aid the county in selling any wireless assets that may be replaced by any upgrades by the county

Section 2 – Warranty / Guarantee

FDDI provides a 1 year warranty on equipment that is manufactured and sold by FDDI. FDDI will act as a proxy on behalf of the county for any 3rd party equipment that may require warranty or repair work. For site survey engineering and frequency analysis FDDI can only warrant unlicensed work for the day that the survey was

taken. For licensed radio work, FDDI will guarantee the analysis through the immediate filing (within 2 weeks) for the target frequency after the RF analysis was completed.


