Dean Andrews was born in Childress Texas and graduated from Childress High School. Dean is a graduate of Cisco Junior College and received his B.S. and M.Ed. from West Texas State University. He received his Administrative Certification from Texas Tech University and his Ed.D. from California Coast University.

Dr. Andrews began his teaching and coaching career in Ropesville, Texas. He served as a teacher coach in Tahoka before becoming a school administrator. Dr. Andrews served as an elementary school principal in Tahoka and then as a junior high/high school principal in Lorenzo. Dr. Andrews has spent the last 34 years as a school superintendent in Lorenzo, Plains, Mexia, and Liberty Hill.

He became superintendent of Liberty Hill ISD on January 1, 1999 and served until September 1, 2008. The Liberty Hill district grew from 1,129 students to 2,446 during his tenure. During the years as school superintendent, Dr. Andrews was responsible for budget planning, and expenditure oversight, personnel approval, day to day operations, academic success, construction of more than 40 projects, safety, and long range planning to meet the academic needs of the various communities in which he served.
