COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2009, Williamson County Judge Dan A. Gattis issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for Williamson County resulting from

The widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of livestock or property resulting from the effects of ongoing drought conditions.

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT of Williamson County, Texas:

- 1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for the severe drought conditions by County Judge Dan A. Gattis on March 16, 2009 shall continue until terminated by order of the Commissioners Court.
- 2. This Court Order is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to the Williamson County Emergency Management Plan and shall become effective on the 17th day of March, 2009.
