A RESOLUTION OF WILLIAMSON COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO SIGN ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR THE SUBMITTAL OF THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners Court seeks to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Williamson County and adjoining areas; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County Commissioners Court is committed to ensuring that all students who attend school in Williamson County, can utilize physically active transportation, such as walking and bicycling, for a safe and enjoyable trip to school; and

WHEREAS, the CITY OF GEORGETOWN, TEXAS and the GEORGETOWN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT have undertaken to obtain a grant from the Texas Safe Routes to School program, to provide infrastructure to the city and to school campuses to ensure and encourage students to walk or bicycle to school; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVLED BY THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT:

That the governing body of Williamson County, on behalf of its citizens, declares, by and through this resolution, that Williamson County supports and endorses fully the efforts that have been made to obtain the Safe Routes to School grant and, further, hereby authorizes its County Judge to sign and submit all necessary documents to apply for the Safe Routes to School Program through the Texas Department of Transportation.
