Re: 2009 TCEQ MSW Annual Report for the Williamson County Landfill

Dear Judge Gattis:

As required by the Williamson County Landfill Operation Agreement (Agreement) signed March 3, 2009 between Williamson County and Waste Management of Texas, Inc. (WMTX), WMTX hereby submits the TCEQ Annual Report for the Williamson County landfill pursuant to section 4.4(a) of the Agreement.

The attached TCEO Annual Report (exhibit 1) reflects the TCEO fiscal year period from 9/1/08 through 8/31/09. During that time period, the Williamson County landfill received 290,663 tons of waste for disposal and diverted 16,984 tons of brush and 28,451 tons of C&D during this period. The attached Waste Management Inc. monthly reports to Williamson County related to Williamson County Landfill (exhibit 2) reflects the tonnages, revenues, fees, and pass-through charges for each month since the Agreement was signed on March 3, 2009 along with a summary report for the period from 9/1/08 through 8/31/09.

In calendar year 2009, the Williamson County Recycling Center received over 6,000 visitors and recycled 363,280 lbs of scrap metal, 23,420 lbs of plastic, 54,059 lbs of paper, 178,280 lbs of cardboard, 4,200 lbs of Aluminum, 74,000 lbs of e-waste, and 2,538 gallons of used oil. On October 10, 2009, WMTX sponsored a household hazardous waste collection event for Williamson County Residents. A total of 46,719 lbs of waste was collected from 477 Williamson County residents who participated in the Household Hazardous Waste Event.

Pursuant to Section 4.4 (b) of the Agreement, the annual Tonnage Limit has been updated using the latest available TCEQ Annual Report. The average annual estimated waste generation rate is 7.6 lbs/person/day. Based on the 2008 U.S. Census the Williamson County population has grown to approximately 394,193 residents. Using this information, the projected Annual Tonnage Limit calculation for the upcoming year is 546,745 tons. However, please recall that Section 4.4(b) of the Agreement provides that "in no event shall the Tonnage Limit be less than 590,000 tons annually." Accordingly, the Tonnage Limit for 2010, as defined in the Agreement, will be 590,000 tons.
