

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Williamson County, that the JABG Community Mentoring Program, Application Number 2312201, be operated for the 1st year; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County Commissioners Court has considered the proposed application for State and Federal Assistance for said project, in the amount of \$29,803 to be submitted to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, Fund JJDP Program; and

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners Court has agreed to provide a ten - percent (10%) matching moneys for the said project in the amount of \$3,311, or an amount equal to one-fourth of the total project cost, as required by the grant application; and

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners Court has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, Williamson County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.

WHEREAS, The Williamson County Commissioners Court has agreed that a designation of the title of an authorized official who is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant is hereby identified as the Williamson County Judge.

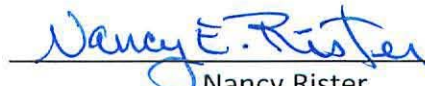
