We spoke a few weeks ago about the Texas 4000 for Cancer ATLAS Ride that will be taking place this summer. I submitted the online approval form, but I wanted to send you an email with the same information, especially since I can also include a map of the route. So, here are the details:

2010 ATLAS Ride (benefitting the Texas 4000 for Cancer organization and MD Anderson Cancer Center)

Type of Event: Community Bicycle Ride (not race)

Date/Time: June 5, 2010, beginning at 8am

Location: Starts at Running Brushy Middle School, Cedar Park, TX and ends at Pillar Bluff Vineyards, Lampasas, TX

Number of Projected Registrants: 700 riders

Route Basics: The 700 riders will leave Running Brushy Middle School at 8am, will travel north on Lakeline Blvd, turn right on Crystal Falls Pkwy, and left on Bagdad Rd.

The ride will continue on to Liberty Hill, TX and beyond to Lampasas, TX. (see attached route map for details)

NOTE: As indicated on the attached map, the 25 mile route will loop around after reaching Liberty Hill, and will travel back to Running Brushy Middle School.
