Waste comes from 33 counties.

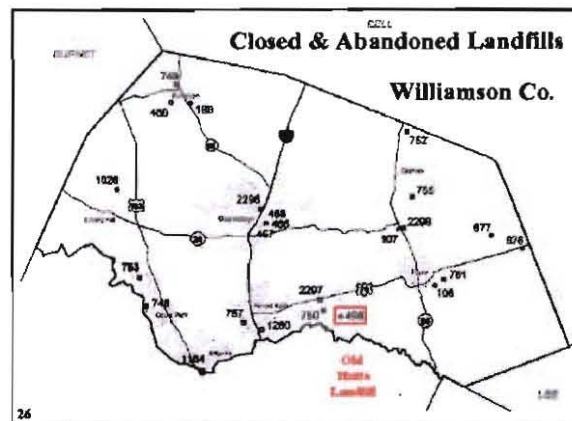
