

CONTRACT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 5 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT to contract for engineering services is by and between Williamson County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, (the "County") and Klotz Associates, Inc. (the "Engineer") and becomes effective when fully executed by both parties.

WHEREAS, the County and the Engineer executed a contract (SWA4 to PSA) on January 1, 2010;

WHEREAS, the not-to-exceed fee in the agreement to \$1,979,056.00; and,

WHEREAS, the "Compensation Cap" in Exhibit 1, Section 4, Item 4.3 limits the maximum amount payable under the agreement to \$1,979,056.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Hourly Rates in Exhibit II are limited to the rates noted; and,

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to amend the agreement.

AGREEMENT


NOW, THEREFORE, premises considered, the *County* and the *Engineer* agree that said contract is amended as follows:

- I. The not-to-exceed fee in Exhibit 1, Section 1, Item 1. I is hereby increased from \$1,979,056.00 to \$2,100,000.00.
- II. The Compensation Cap in Exhibit 1, Section 4, Item 4.3 is hereby increased from \$1,979,056.00 to \$2,100,000.00.
- III. The hourly rates presented in Exhibit II for Supplemental #4 to the PSA are still in effect.

All other provisions are unchanged and remain in full force and effect.

WORK AUTHORIZATION NO. 2
