Adopt-a-Park Program

The Williamson County Parks and Recreation Department (the Department) is seeking community based volunteer groups (Volunteers) to participate in our Adopt-a-Park program. The Adopt-a-Park program is volunteer supported, and invites one year partnership opportunities that will help build a sense of community pride and ownership around parks, trails, and facilities.

Volunteers can help Williamson County Parks in a variety of ways:

- Park preservation and care
- Trail projects
- Habitat restoration
- Special events
- Outdoor education

The Program

Volunteers must be willing to:

- Organize community based volunteer groups
- Commit to a minimum of one year of service
- Participate in at least 4 major events during the service year
- Coordinate volunteer efforts with existing park users
- Document volunteer activities / hours, donations, and / or financial contributions, and provide this information to the Department quarterly
- Operate within assigned duties as approved by the Department
- Coordinate with the Department (via an approval form) before beginning any special projects on park lands (e.g. tree removal or planting, construction, facility / grounds renovation, park maintenance and improvements, trail projects, etc)
- Coordinate use of any power tools or power equipment on park lands
- Follow all Department rules and regulations, and follow all industry standards and guidelines that regulate intended activities
- Conduct yourself in a manner that reflects the positive partnership and professional commitment of both the Department and the volunteer.
- Be known as a volunteer, and not a Williamson County Parks & Recreation Department employee

Williamson County PARD will:

- Review, consider, and approve proposals
- Encourage, guide, support, monitor, and provide leadership to the volunteers.
- Provide basic tools where possible.
- Recognize only one support group per park, facility, or section of trail per year
- Erect a sign that recognizes the name (or acronym) of the volunteers adopting the park or facility (must initially complete 100 hours of service and remain engaged through the year)
