Change Order No. 17

Reason for Change

The original plans did not provide adequate quantities for the Type C asphalt needed on the project. Therefore, this Change Order increases the plan quantity of the Type C asphalt in order for the contractor to receive compensation for this work.

In addition, it was necessary to relocate an existing illumination assembly near the FM 619 intersection since the assembly was too close to the edge of the new pavement. Therefore, this Change Order adds the pay item below in order to reimburse the contractor for this work.

Following is a description of the new item required for this Change Order.

This Change Order results in a net increase of \$304,028.33 to the Contract amount, for an adjusted total Contract amount of \$20,305,071.62. The original Contract amount was \$20,021,693.92. As a result of this and all Change Orders to date, \$283,377.70 has been added to the Contract, resulting in a 1.42% net increase in the Contract Cost. No additional days will be added to the Contract as a result of this Change Order.
