



**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF WILLIAMSON
IN SUPPORT OF THE UPPER BRUSHY CREEK WCID's FLOOD PROTECTION
PLANNING GRANT APPLICATION**

WHEREAS the Texas Water Development Board offers grants to political subdivisions through the Flood Protection Planning Program, and

WHEREAS the Upper Brushy Creek WCID is authorized to apply for a grant from the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB), and

WHEREAS flood protection planning should be based on watershed boundaries rather than political or jurisdictional boundaries, and

WHEREAS the Upper Brushy Creek WCID Boundaries encompass approximately 187 square miles in southern Williamson County,


WHEREAS the Upper Brushy Creek WCID is offering to sponsor a basin-wide flood protection planning study provides Williamson County a unique opportunity to participate in the regional planning study that will identify potential regional flood damage reduction projects;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. That Williamson County endorses the Upper Brushy Creek WCID's application for a Flood Protection Planning Grant.

Section 2. Williamson County will provide support to the Upper Brushy Creek WCID during the study through staff participation in a Technical Advisory Committee to provide technical reviews and identification of potential regional flood damage reduction projects.

Section 3. Williamson County will participate with the implementation of potential regional flood damage reduction projects within its jurisdiction to the extent practicable. Such support may include but is not limited to staff participation in a Technical Advisory Committee during design development, review, permitting; and/or partial funding; or support in the Upper Brushy Creek WCID's application for future grants.
