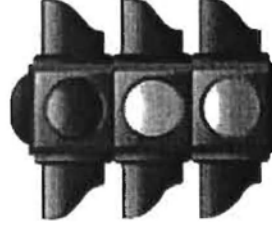

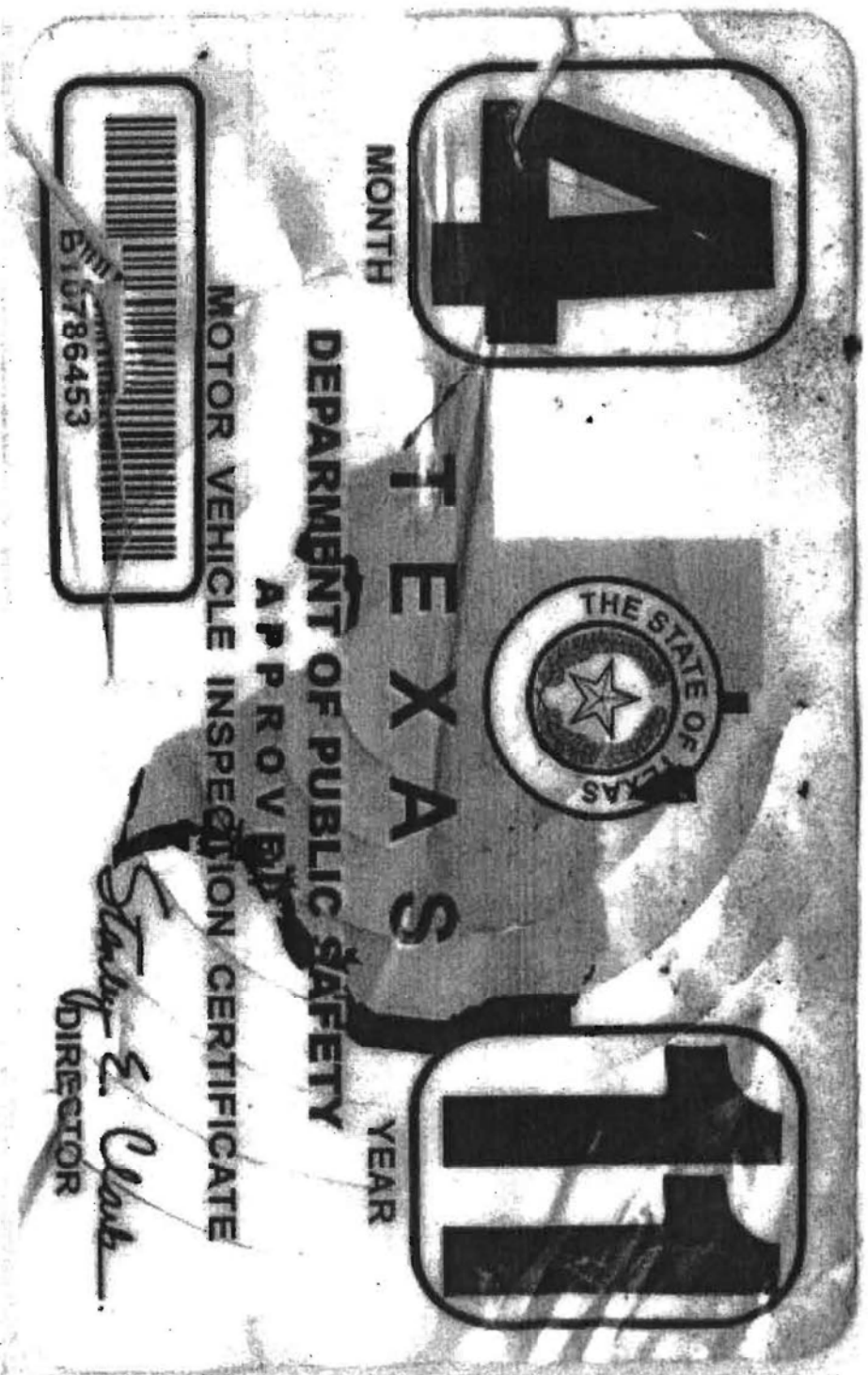

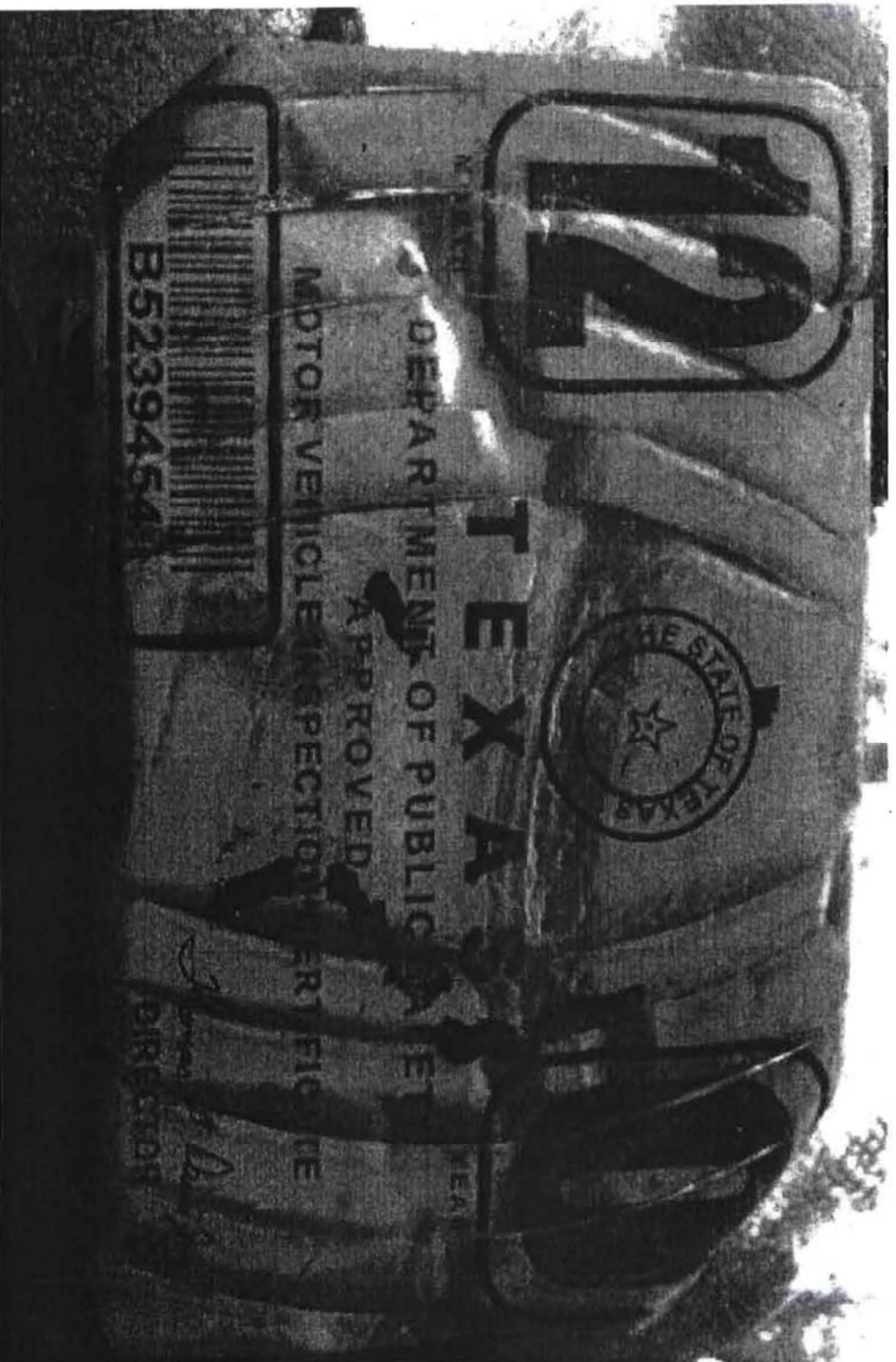
NOTABLE CASES

- \$3,300 in stolen merchandise (10 baseball bats) recovered by Deputy Wilson and Deputy Baxter, WCSO on MVI stop.

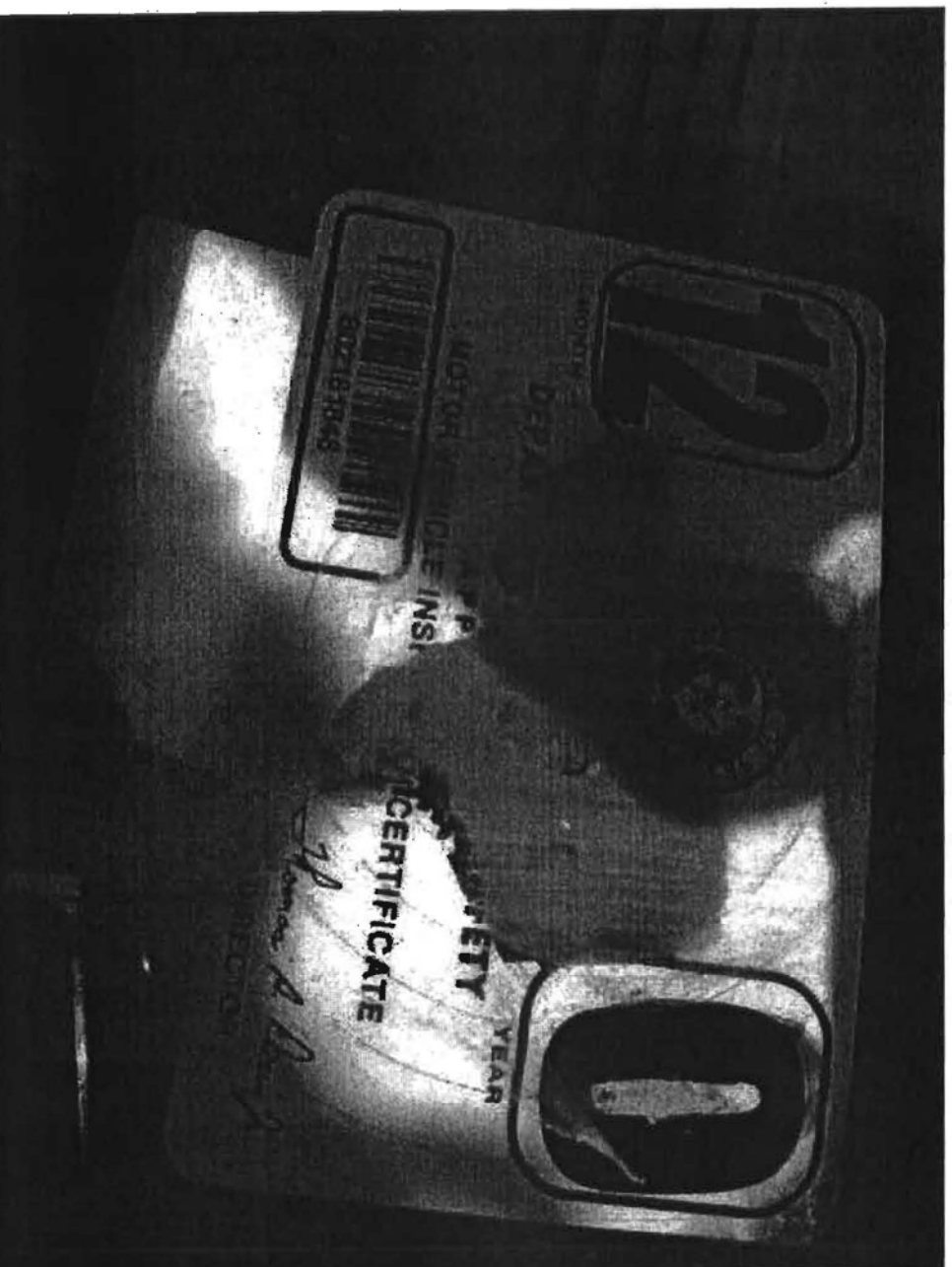

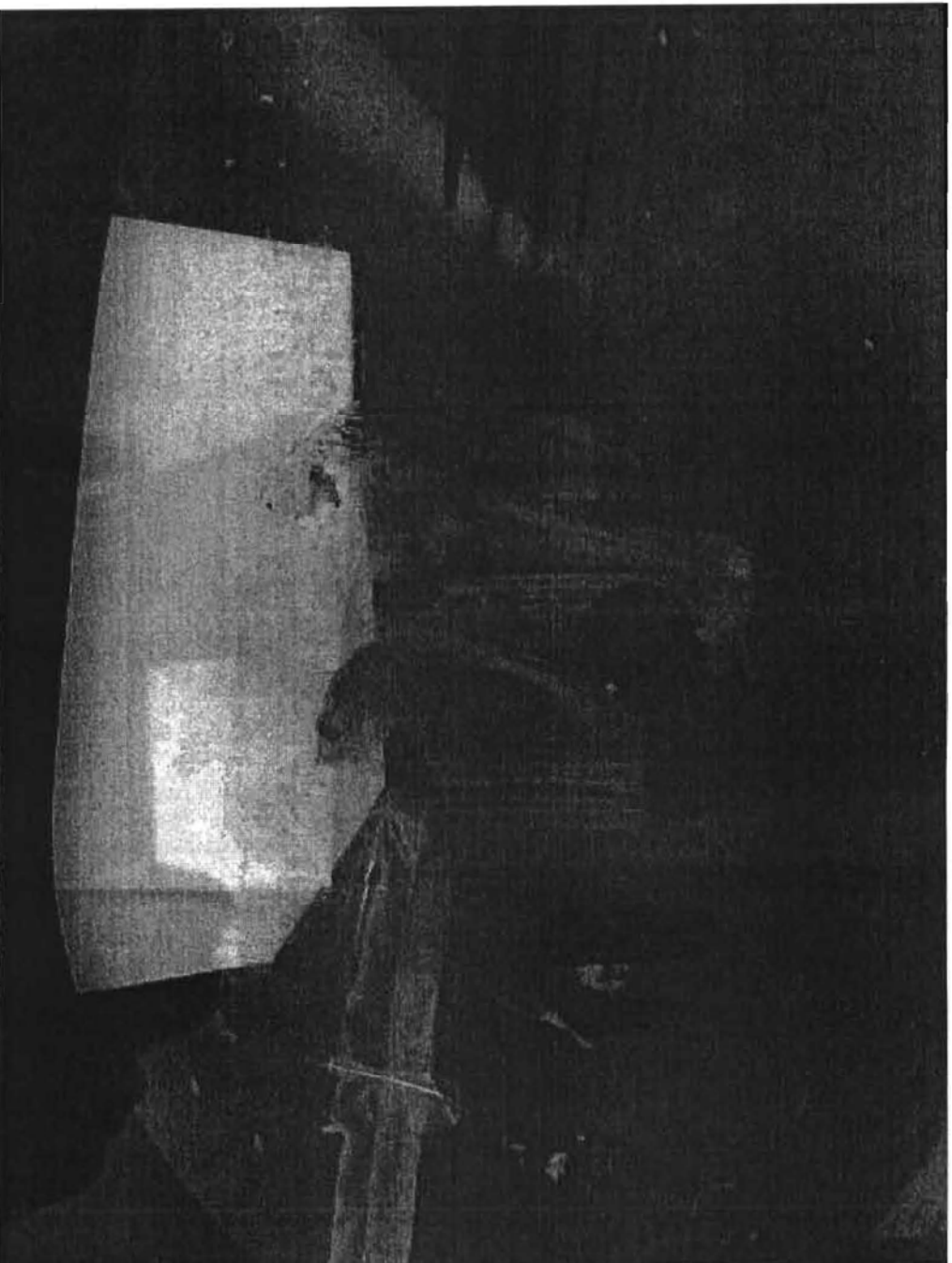
Counterfeit MVI Certificate
