Change Order No. 3

Reason for Change

This Change Order documents the overruns and underruns to the quantities required to perform the work in the contract. Final quantities changed due to an error in the initial design and changed conditions in the field.

- The quantity of removal of the existing stabilized base parking lot was decreased because it was determined in the field that the base did not have to be removed.
- The Contractor excavated to plan grade for the flex base before it was
 determined that the grade of the new pavement had to be raised to match the
 existing parking lot. Raising the grade increased the amount of flex base needed
 for the parking lot widening.
- Additional hot mix was required to shape the existing parking lot surface to drain to the location called out in the plans.
- The property owner requested that the water quality pond location be adjusted away from his building approximately 8 feet, which shortened the length of the pipe from the inlet to the pond.

This Change Order results in a net increase of \$1,078.80 to the Contract amount, for an adjusted Contract amount of \$81,762.65. The original Contract amount was \$74,636.00. As a result of this and all Change Orders to-date, \$7,126.65 has been added to the Contract, resulting in a 9.5% net increase in the Contract Cost. No days will be added to or deducted from the Contract as a result of this Change Order.
