

## INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

Pursuant to Texas Government Code, Chapter 791, the City of Granger, Texas ("City"), wishes to enter into an Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") with the Williamson County Road & Bridge Division, acting by and through Williamson County, Texas ("County"), to remove debris and large vegetation that is reducing the channel flow capacity of a storm water channel located behind the homes on South Schramm Road. A description of the services to be performed, location of work site and the estimate of labor and costs is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Upon completion of the services described in Exhibit "A", the County shall invoice the City for the total actual costs of all labor and equipment used to perform the services. The City shall pay the County within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of the invoice.

Cost Estimate for Clearing Drainage Channel (Shown in Figure 1 below),

### **Scope:**

Set up and remove trees and debris from drainage South of FM 971. Williamson County Road and Bridge has received permission from Kurt Shelman, an adjacent landowner to drainage channel, to push trees and brush on to his property for burning at a later date.
