Notice of Contract Termination for Invitation for Bid # 14IFB00225 - Asphalt Emulsions

To Whom It May Concern:

As you are aware, Williamson County is currently in a contract with Western Emulsions, Inc. for asphalt emulsion services. The Williamson County Commissioners Court, as the legislative body for the county, has decided to make changes in this category of services, including the present contract with Western Emulsions, Inc.. Pursuant to Section 3.2.8(b) of the contract documents (Invitation for Bid #14IFB00225), which allows for termination with a thirty (30) day notice:

Termination for Convenience: Williamson County may terminate the Contract and/or any ensuing Agreement for convenience and without cause or further liability, upon thirty (30) calendar day's written notice to Successful Bidder. In the event Williamson County exercises its right to terminate without cause, it is understood and agreed that only the amounts due to the Successful Bidder for goods, commodities and/or services provided and expenses incurred to and including the date of termination, will be due and payable. No penalty will be assessed for Williamson County's termination for convenience.

Therefore, the purpose of this letter is to give Western Emulsions, Inc. official notice that Williamson County elects to terminate the agreement between the parties for asphalt emulsion services, and such termination will be effective in thirty (30) calendar days.
